**Grant Awards** – for doctors, nurses and basic scientists:

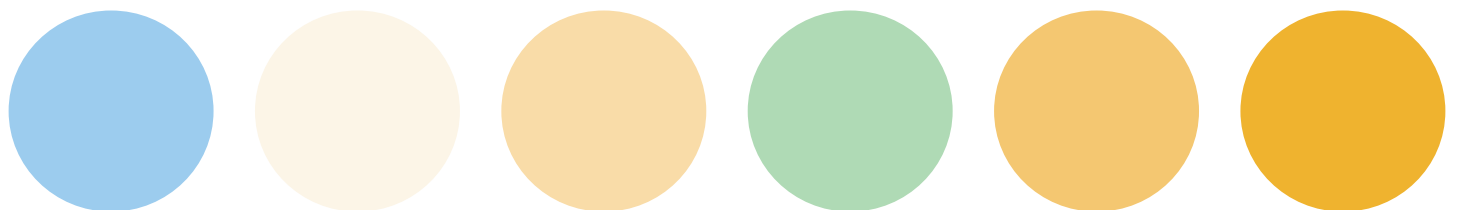
- Small research project grants up to £12,000 (up to 3 awards available)
