We are now inviting applications for research and education funding in diabetes for 2021, all awards are made on a competitive basis.

Applicants are preferred to be working in a patient facing role but this is not an absolute requirement.

The Foundation is an independent registered charity: 1056410, AMRC member and a NIHR partner. Awards will be announced in April 2021.

Closing date for Fellowship and Grant: 10 December 2020

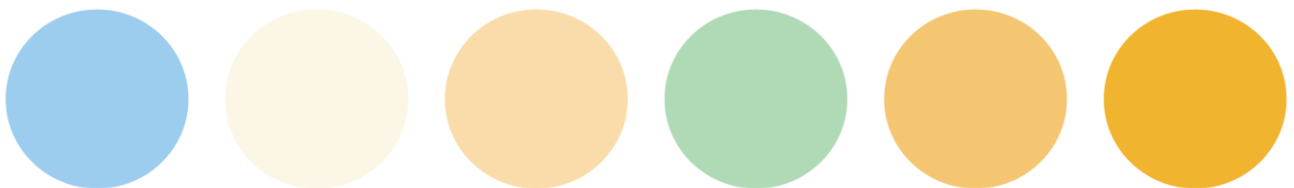
Closing date for the Fund Awards: 1 February 2021

Research Fellowships – this award is open to all healthcare professionals (e.g. doctors, nurses, podiatrists, dieticians...) working in diabetes and wishing to undertake a PhD: 3 years full-time, 4 years full-time with MSc year 1, or 5 years part-time.

Grant Awards – small research project grants in diabetes up to £12,000 open to all applicants.

Fund Awards – for nurses and allied healthcare professionals in diabetes care.

- Attendance at a national or international meeting (preference to those presenting their work) up to £1,000.
- A course of study up to £2,000.
- Clinical project up to £5,000.
